JOB:	How to reprogramme TD5 EUI injectors

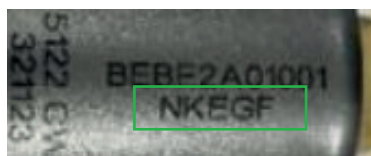
Electronic Unit Injectors on the TD5 engine fitted to Land Rover vehicles feature a unique 5-digit grading code. Assigned during manufacture, this code represents the injector's measured flow and operating characteristics and allows the ECU to compensate for any injector-to-injector variation.

Where can you find the grading code?

As an OE-approved remanufacturer, we allocate a brand new grading code to every injector we remanufacture. This is etched on to the side of the actuator, along with the part number and manufacturer data, making it visible when fitted to the engine.



- » part number
- » new grading code
- » manufacturer data



- » 5-digit grading code

When installing the injector into the engine, the 5-digit grading code must be reprogrammed into the ECU using an appropriate EOB tool. The grading code will only contain alpha characters and no numeric characters - the example shown is NKEGF.

Note: if a grading code is visible on top of the injector actuator, ignore this and use the code on the side of the actuator body, as shown.

Failure to program the new grading code could result in the following issues:

- » rough engine operation/running
- » combustion noise/knock
- » high fuel consumption
- » visible exhaust smoke

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
